

## How to Use Social Media Legally in Workplace

The use of social media in the workplace has increased rapidly and the spontaneous and farreaching character of social media posts makes them extremely powerful in promoting an organizations' brand and also giving rise to platforms that facilitate the interaction of employees, employers and clients. However, it also raises legal issues, for example, those relating to privacy and personal data protection in personal and cooperate level, trademark or copyright infringement, social media marketing, labor relations, defamation, discrimination, internet abuse (cyber slacking, cyber bullying) and sometimes even criminal liability.

## **Course Objectives**

This course is designed to assist the participants to understand relevant statutes, e.g. Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486, Law of Hong Kong), Disability Discrimination Ordinance (Cap. 487, Law of Hong Kong), Race Discrimination Ordinance (Cap. 602, Law of Hong Kong), Defamation Ordinance (Cap. 21, Law of Hong Kong) etc. and relevant court judgments in relation to the use of social media so as to assist them to formulate a proper and practical social media management within the workplace in order to protect the right and interest of the cooperates, employees, also to facilitate the business relationship with clients.
